

Subj :- Establishment of Sainik School in Mizoram.

Sir,

It has been a cherished dream of the Mizos to have a premier educational institution like a Sainik School in Mizoram as provided under rules and regulations of Sainik Schools Society. A suitable plot of land has been identified and provisionally demarcated for the purpose near Chhingchhip village about 80 Kms from Aizawl on N H 54 (Aizawl-Lunglei Road).

The detailed project report prepared by the State PWD has estimated the cost of construction of the Sainik School at Chhingchhip at Rs. 48.40 crores. The proposed Sainik School anticipates becoming a role model for new educational institutions within the State and other North Eastern States. In order to achieve this by promoting a sustainable utilization of the land and by establishing a built environment that harmonizes a functional, aesthetic and social needs of all who work, teach, study and live in the campus, a large acreage measuring about 212 hectares (subject to final demarcation on the basis of actual needs) has been tentatively earmarked for establishment of the school.

Keeping the above in mind, the Council of Ministers has approved the proposal for the establishment of Sainik School in Mizoram. May I therefore, on behalf of the Government of Mizoram, request you to place our proposal before the Board of Governors of the Sainik Schools Society to accord normal approval for establishment of a Sainik School in the State.
