**SAINIK SCHOOL CHHINGCHHIP, MIZORAM WAS INAUGURATED BY HON'BLE CHIEF MINISTER, SHRI LAL THANHWALA ON 17TH MAY 2017 AS THE 26TH SAINIK SCHOOL AT CHHINGCHHIP (MIZORAM).**

Sainik School Chhingchhip is the 26th school and the latest in the chronology of Sainik Schools running under the aegis of Sainik Schools Society, Ministry of Defence registered under society registration act (xxi of 1860).

The school primary aim is to prepare the cadets academically, physically and mentally to enter the portals of the national defence academy. The school endeavours to develop character, team spirit, loyalty, esprit-de-corps and a high sense of discipline.

Sainik School Chhingchhip is located in the interior of a peaceful and serene state of Mizoram and is located around 70 kms from the capital of Mizoram. The school stands on 40 acres of land, donated free of cost by 60 families of Chhingchhip town, a part of Serchhip district.

The school was inaugurated on the 17th May 2017 by Shri Lal Thanhawla, the Honorable Chief Minister of Mizoram and has started its first batch of class VI comprising of 60 cadets.

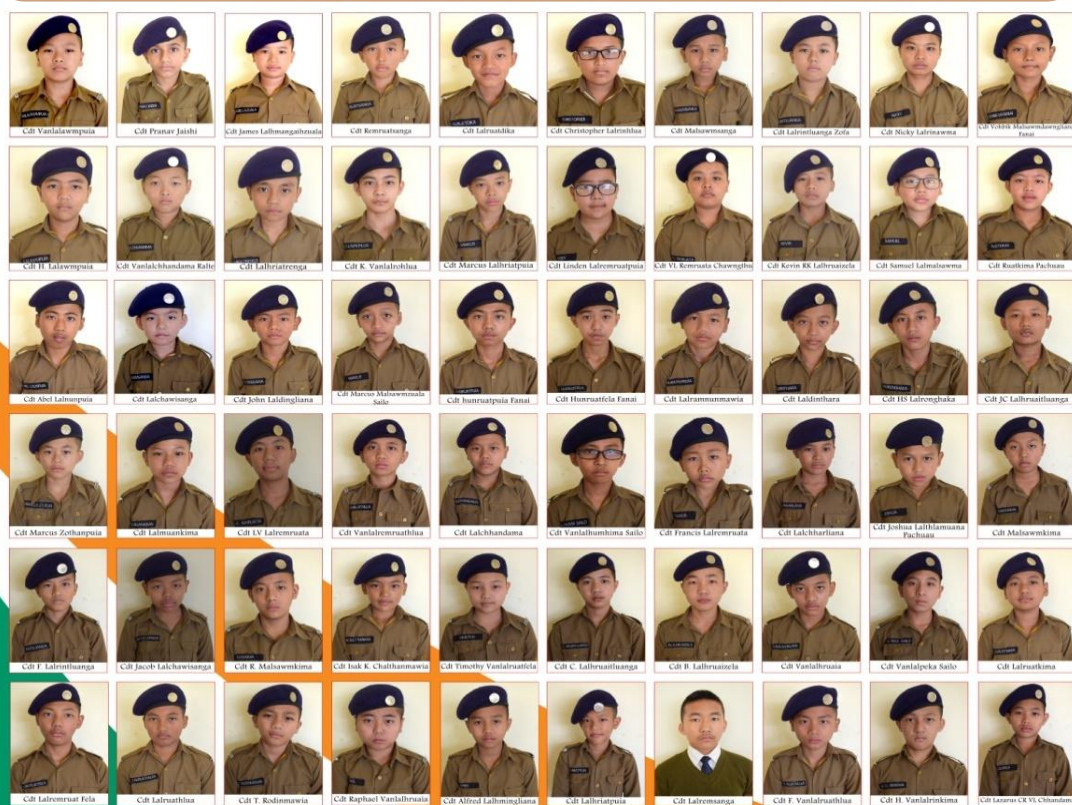

### Responsibilities of Govt of Mizoram as per MoA

- Provide land and infrastructure like buildings, play grounds, swimming pool, etc
- Provide all the equipment, including transports.
- Grant scholarships to the boys depending on the income of the parents.
- Special grant-in-aid to meet special requirement on actual need basis on recommendations of the LBA.
- Provided a sum of Rs 1.94 crore, Rs 1.62 crore and 9.9 lakh as 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> installment respectively for salary, scholarships, infrastructural development and to meet the basic requirement.

### Responsibilities of Ministry of Defence as per MoA

- Provide three service officers -Principal, Vice Principal and Adm Officer.
- Provide NCC staff for NCC trg and Army Physical Training Corps (APTC)NCOs for physical trg of the cadets.
- Provide central share of scholarship.
- Provide supervision and control through the Sainik Schools Society functioning under MoD.
- School shall be governed by the Sainik Schools Society rules & regulations 1997, as amended from time to time.

## Admission of Girl Student.

On approval from the Sainik Schools Society, Ministry of Defence for induction of Girl Student in Sainik School Chhingchhip from the State of Mizoram, the advertisement for sale of Prospectus for girls was published in "The Mizoram Post" - the English daily, "Vanglaini" - the Mizo daily and "Mizoram Udaya" - Hindi weekly. The Sale of Prospectus for girls was carried out wef 21 Dec to 30 Dec 17 from Sainik School Chhingchhip and Directorate of School Education, Aizawl, Mizoram.

The Entrance Examination consists of a written examination followed by an interview of short listed candidates. The written papers for Class VI as under:-

## Admissions

- 54 Boys and 06 Girls will be admitted in Class VI for the Academic Session 2018-19.
- Three centres for the exams were - Aizawl, Chhingchhip and Lunglei.
- Written, Interview and Medical test was conducted on 07<sup>th</sup> Jan 2018 at three centres, 19<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> Feb 2018 at 46 Assam Rifles and Civil Hospital, Aizawl respectively.
- Final admissions will take place in the month of April 2018.

## Reservation

- 67% of the seats in each Sainik School will be reserved for boys from the state in which the Sainik School is located. The shortfall, if any, and the remaining seats will be thrown open to boys from other states and union territories.
- 15% of the total seats are reserved for scheduled castes and 7  $\frac{1}{2}$  seats for scheduled tribes.
- 25% seats are reserved for children of service personnel including ex-servicemen.

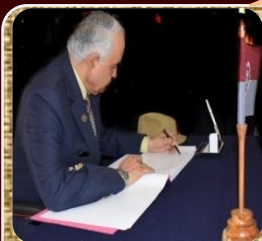

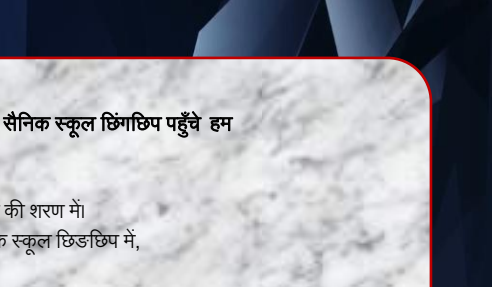
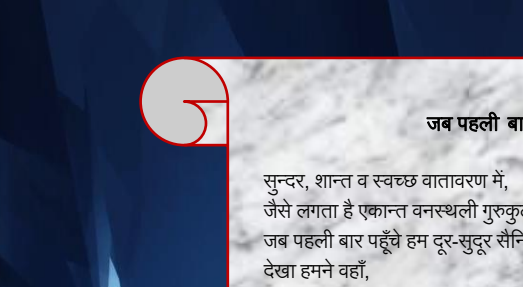
